Julie Adler's recent exhibition of paintings, monoprints, etchings, linocuts and more at Campbell Hall Art Gallery suggests a fiercely compelling and singular mind at work. Mining an intensely personal vein and responding to the luminous poem, *Song of Myself* by Walt Whitman, Adler's interpretations of Whitman's words expand the essential poetic impulse that fuels the truly maverick and original, excising demons, both real and imagined. Works like *1% Contained* represent the landscape of imagination, skewed and strangely ecstatic, as the artist appears to be climbing either away from herself, or back in.
